Last week while on vacation, I was following the reports of Hurricane Matthew. Nancy & I lived in Saint Augustine, Florida for nine years and the images of waste-deep water flooding most of downtown was sad to see. One photo showed pumpkins floating down King Street away from the Methodist Church where they are an important annual fundraiser. Flooding and damage have been devastating in the southeastern states particularly along the coast.

The scenes from Haiti, though, are tragic. The southern peninsula was hit head-on with 145 mph winds. Most of the homes could not stand the wind and waves of Matthew. And the number of victims keeps rising as rescue teams finally reach areas that had been made inaccessible by the hurricane.

Once again, Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA) is on the ground. Actually, they've been in Haiti since the devastating 2010 earthquake. When PDA responds to a disaster, they are in it for the long-haul. For this latest crisis, PDA is supplying essential food, water, and supplies. Once long-term needs are determined, PDA will shift to providing the assistance for a comprehensive recovery.
